Description of 7th Grade Initiative

The 7th grade initiative is a program provided by the Waynesboro Area YMCA. Any 7th graders within the Waynesboro Area School District can receive a YMCA membership provided by the Y at no cost for the school year. 7th graders are also able to participate in this after school pavilion program. The main purpose of providing this service is to ensure that students will always have a safe place to be after school. While staff will be facilitating the program, students can excuse themselves in and out of the program.

Discipline Policy

This year we have decided to create a policy that better conveys what we expect from each student who enters through our doors. We firmly believe that participating in this program at the YMCA is a privilege and there may be times where action may warrant a consequence. Attached you will find a revised policy that outlines behavior we find inappropriate or destructive to the YMCA facilities or YMCA members. While at the Y, members are expected to practice social distancing and be respectful of the personal boundaries of other members. If anyone is not following social distancing guidelines, they will be asked to leave.
